

ABSTRACT

Essential to any successful organization, the periodic evaluation of its operations, services, facilities and fixed assets provide the leadership with the necessary tools to keep the agency healthy and in a state of readiness for the future and all that it may hold.

The purpose of this matrix is to provide the user with a comprehensive evaluation of their current facilities as well as to guide them through a needs assessment and design for planned or future facilities and/or fixed assets.

Critical to any inclination an organization may desire in upgrading or replacing its existing facility(s), is the intentional, evaluative exercise of

- □ Defining the organization
- Establishing a current mission statement
- Adopting a vision for the organization

- □ Develop and adopt a Deployment Plan
- Design facilities to meet all of the above now and in the future

Public Safety facilities typically have a life-span that extends for decades. That principle alone must drive policy-makers of any organization to carefully consider all three dimensions of their services: past, present and future. Having the patience and taking the effort to work through a process (as shown below) that develops a true Facilities Master PLAN – insures that a fire station is an integral part of fulfilling the 'PLAN' – rather than a 'PLAN' being squeezed into a facility.



ADMINISTRATIVE USE AREAS




OPERATIONS / RESPONSE AREAS

Generally OFF LIMITS to the general public except for guided tours, this includes the spaces for apparatus, equipment, decontamination, maintenance, storage and other Operations and Support Services Division activities.

SUPPORT SERVICES USE AREAS: Those <u>secure</u> areas of the Fire Station where the support services and maintenance activities take place. Generally OFF LIMITS to the general public except for guided tours, this includes the spaces for apparatus and equipment repair, SCBA filling/storage, cleaning and decontamination, storage and other Support Services operations occur.
