For summer/outdoor options

MVC/Extrication from dispatch to RTQ - not just jaws

- Drafting
- MCI drill

Winter options

- SCBA fundamentals...not just quarterly's
- Ambulance orientation
- Decontamination set up and operation
- Drags & Carries for RIT
- Mayday, LUNA and firefighter assessment in RIT
- PT packaging/moving in tight spaces
- Roles on the truck and fire ground behavior - unit cohesion vs chaotic free-for-all

Specialized training sessions (A/Os)

- Pump operations
- Troubleshooting low pressure
- Drafting - advanced issues
- Hydraulic and fluid dynamics...friction, head pressure, pressure loss, pressure vs volume
- Managing nozzle, water source, tools, IC, radio

Officer (LTs/Capt) Training

- Command and managing your team
- Comms
- Size ups and tasking orders
